Naloxone (Narcan®) is a medication that reverses the effects of an opioid overdose. Anyone at risk of having or seeing an opioid overdose, or who spends time with people who use opioids should consider carrying naloxone.

Just ask an Emergency Department staff member for Naloxone or Narcan®. A staff member will provide a rescue kit after going over the signs and symptoms of an opioid overdose and how to use Narcan.
