The Centerstone Halfway House facility offers 71-beds for individuals needing additional support in a recovery based, integrative environment. The Halfway House is a transitional living facility for those who are new to recovery and are committed to a full life away from addiction.

The Halfway House is conveniently located near the RIDES Mass Transit line, which makes transportation easy.

The program offers the following services:

- Up to 90 days of service, based on individual need
- A structured living environment
- Individual and group counseling, along with community support
- An array of evidence-based group programming
- Vocational services to assist in obtaining employment, including resume building and job placement
- Skill-building that focuses on independent living
- Case management services to assist with release planning
- Numerous recovery-based meetings in the community
- Services are provided on a sliding-fee scale through DASA and private pay
- No waitlist

**Residential Treatment** – Inpatient services is a more intense level of treatment for individuals with severe or long term substance abuse addictions. It is appropriate for individuals that are unable to remain abstinent from alcohol or other drugs in an Out-Patient setting. It offers individuals the opportunity to focus on recovery, free from outside distractions and negative influences. Clients receive education, participate in group therapy sessions and receive private sessions with an assigned counselor while in this level of care.

Bring insurance card if you have any kind of health insurance (this applies only to outpatient services). The verification used to determine if you are eligible for funding assistance. This is a requirement of the State of Illinois.

Gateway Foundation Alcohol & Drug Treatment Center has residential services for adult men, women, adolescent girls, and adolescent boys. Gateway has specialized programs for co-occurring mental health. Adolescents who are in residential treatment will continue their schooling on site with teachers from Carbondale Community High.

A 24-hour phone line is answered by a trained professional who can screen and schedule appointments, place on waitlists, or answer any questions from prospective clients or concerned family members and friends. Most insurances, no funds, Medicaid, and self-pay accepted.

Addiction treatments aim to address all aspects of substance use disorder. Gateway treats the social, behavioral, and physical elements of addiction through comprehensive care services. Depending on symptoms and circumstances, patients may receive services such as:

- Cognitive-behavioral therapy
- Dual diagnosis treatment
- Mindfulness-based sobriety
- Dialectical behavior therapy
- Acceptance and commitment therapy
- 12-Step facilitation
- Trauma-informed therapy
- Support groups and group therapy
- Motivational interviewing therapy
- Medication-assisted treatment
- Age-based and gender-based patient group involvement
