

COVID-19 Assistance for Older Adults 60+

Shawnee Alliance, the social services division of **Shawnee Health Service**, has received an Emergency Assistance Services grant from Illinois Department on Aging in response to COVID-19.

These grant funds will be used to assist older adults 60+ with unmet needs related to COVID-19 and isolation. **Older adults 60+ in Shawnee Alliance's 18-county service area are eligible for this assistance.**

These unmet needs may include, but are not limited to:

- Nutritional needs
- Personal care and sanitation needs
- Personal medical care needs
- Transportation services

Counties in Shawnee Alliance's service area which are eligible for assistance include: Alexander, Edwards, Franklin, Gallatin, Hamilton, Hardin, Jackson, Johnson, Massac, Perry, Pope, Pulaski, Saline, Union, Wabash, Wayne, White, and Williamson.

Shawnee Alliance can submit requests to use funds for needs other than these pre-approved areas.
