Families on traditional Medicaid must call the CARES line at (800) 345-9049. After you call the CARES line, Centerstone will respond in Franklin, Jackson, Madison, and Williamson Counties.

FAMILY AND COMMUNITY

Families benefit from the services of trained counselors in their homes and communities through Family Services and via Intensive Placement Stabilization for foster families. COUNSELING

Centerstone's skilled counselors and therapists offer mental health counseling and youth substance abuse counseling at certain locations. Services may include individual or group counseling sessions. Please call the office nearest you for more information.

EARLY CHILDHOOD

Centerstone offers early childhood services to help children reach their full-potential. These include Early Intervention for children three years of age and younger with developmental delays. Early Head Start is a federally funded program for low-income pregnant women and children 0-3. Contact our office for details on what is available in your community.

PREVENTION

Youth prevention services develop collaborations with schools, coalitions and others to encourage healthy behaviors. Centerstone's prevention services focus on teen pregnancy and substance abuse prevention and are available in Franklin and Jackson Counties respectively.

PSYCHIATRY

Psychiatric evaluation and medication monitoring services are available for children at our offices in Alton, Carbondale, Marion and West Frankfort. Please call us for details. In most cases, children and youth will also be engaged in other Centerstone services. Research demonstrates that medication and therapy together ensure the best treatment outcomes.

PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENTS

Psychological assessments and testing for children and youth are available in Carbondale, Marion and West Frankfort. Among the assessments available are psycho-educational and learning disability screening, intelligence (IQ) testing and diagnostic evaluations. Services are offered on a self-pay basis only.
