6.04 Public Communications/ Relations (continued)

Current Policy:

Tobacco use is also prohibited during field visits or while on other department business.

Jackson County Health Department is committed to the concept of wellness, and encourages its employees to be good role models. Consequently, the use of tobacco products in any part of the facility, or on our property, by employees, clients or guests, is prohibited. Tobacco products that are prohibited include but are not limited to; cigarettes, cigars, smokeless tobacco and e-cigarettes or other similar products that rely on vaporization or aerosolization. Tobacco use by employees is also prohibited while conducting department business.
